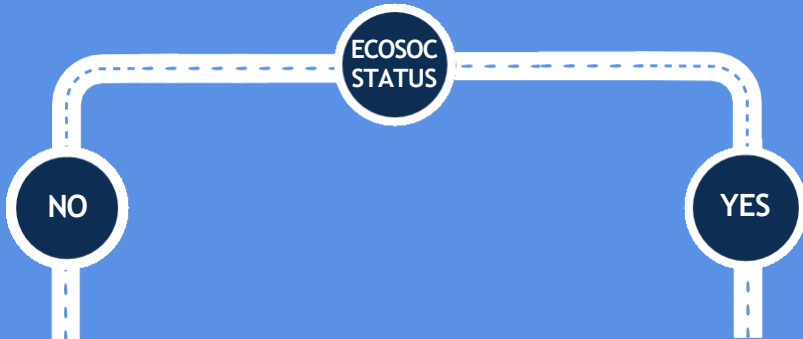


How can NGO representatives attend meetings and conferences at the Palais des Nations?

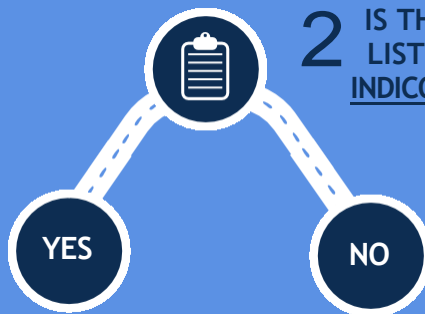

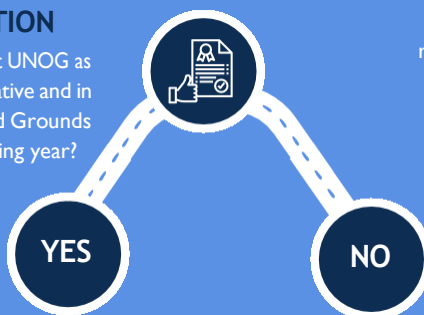

3 REGISTRATION
Are you accredited at UNOG as an NGO representative and in possession of a valid Grounds Pass for the ongoing year?



While in possession of a UNOG grounds pass, NGO representatives obtain access to the Palais des Nations premises. However, most meetings and UN events require online registration and approval, through the UNOG online registration platform [Indico](#).

Register on the UNOG online registration platform [Indico](#) to the meeting of interest and wait to receive your confirmation email containing your QR code to access UN premises.
